

Top End & Kimberleys and Beyond Safari Rules and Cancellation Policy

General

- All participants must be current CMCA members
- Respect the rights of others at all times
- A full tank of fuel at the commencement of the safari
- Make sure all fresh water tanks are full and grey and black water tanks are empty at commencement of the safari
- Dump points must be used for all black and grey water disposal throughout the trip
- Generators must only be used as per camp site rules
- All sites must be left cleaner on departure than arrival
- If dogs are permitted on the safari the owners must comply with CMCA's Dog/Pet Policy below
- Any complaints, incidents or accidents must be reported to NHQ at the earliest convenience

Code of Conduct

This sets out the standards of behaviour expected of members when attending a CMCA event. In agreeing to be part of the event, each member must also agree to adhere to these codes at all times.

Members must:

- Treat everyone with respect
- Consider the welfare of others at all times

Uncooperative behaviour:

- A member who becomes uncooperative or unruly may be asked to leave the event
- Failure to cooperate may result in further action being taken, up to and including legal action
- If this occurs, further action in accordance with the CMCA Constitution may be undertaken and possible expulsion from the Club could occur

CMCA Dog/Pet Policy

- Maximum of two (2) dogs or pets permitted per RV
- Dogs must be wearing a collar whilst in public and be microchipped and registered
- Dogs must be kept under control at all times
- All dogs must be on a lead when in public places. Leads must be no more than two metres long. Extendable/retractable leads are not permitted
- Dogs are not prohibited in areas where food is consumed
- Owners must ensure that dogs/pets are not a nuisance to other members. They should not be left unattended in vehicles for long periods where their barking/howling can cause a nuisance to neighbours
- Dogs that have a tendency to snap or bite should be muzzled when out of their RV
- Owners are responsible for cleaning up any 'mess' deposited by their pet
- Dogs are not to be brought to 'happy hour' gatherings without the express permission of all participants

Cancellation

Should a participant cancel once they have received confirmation, a cancellation fee may apply as follows:

- Bookings confirmed by 15 December 2018, \$500 non refundable booking fee paid
- 4 February 2019, (90 days from start of safari) 30% deposit due, a 20% cancellation fee will apply
- 4 April 2019, (30 days before) balance of fees due, a 65% cancellation fee will apply
- 5 days prior to safari commencement, 80% cancellation fee will apply
- Cancellation fees may be waived or reduced at our discretion
- We recommend all participants have travel insurance
- If a replacement safari participant can be found fees will be refunded in full
- Cancellation fees are calculated on the total safari cost
