RV Friendly Program: The RV Friendly Program is a club initiative aiming to assist RV travellers as they journey throughout Australia. Together, RV Friendly Towns (RVFTs) and RV Friendly Destinations (RVFDs) form a network offering a range of services and facilities to meet the needs of RV travellers.

Self Contained Vehicle (SCV) Policy & Leave No Trace® (LNT) Code of Conduct: Aimed to promote and build awareness, appreciation and respect for our cultural heritage and natural environment, the SCV Policy and LNT Code of Conduct demonstrates the club's commitment to environmental protection. The SCV Policy and LNT Code of Conduct are a means of demonstrating to councils and other authorities that self-contained vehicles need not have a negative impact on the environment, even if a campsite has no facilities.

Dump Point Subsidy Program: Together with KEA Campers, CMCA has installed over 500 free public dump points throughout Australia. The implementation of easily accessible dump points encourages self-contained tourism.

rvSafe: CMCA has established a program aiming to educate RV travellers on RV road safety, focusing on areas including vehicle weight and distribution, speed, towing, communication, licensing and more. The program is funded by the Federal Government and supported by CMCA and aims to minimise road related incidents involving RVs.
