Official Opening of CMCA RV Park Railton

Kentish Council Mayor, Don Thwaites and Campervan and Motorhome Club of Australia Chairman, Garry Lee, will conduct the official opening of the Club's newly developed RV Park in Railton, on Thursday 30 March 2017.

The members' only park, located alongside the existing free camp area in Railton, can accommodate up to 40 self-contained vehicles at any one time and will be open seasonally (ten months), depending on weather conditions.

CMCA CEO, Richard Barwick said 'this is the Club's second RV Park, however, it is the first in Tasmania. It will provide our members with a fantastic low cost accommodation option and in return, will attract more tourists to the area, benefitting the local economy'.

'We are hoping to announce two more sites here in Tasmania in coming months. Tasmania is known for its outstanding support towards RV tourism and we would love to see more of our members visiting the state.'

RV Park Railton will house limited facilities including a dump point, potable water and sheltered areas to accommodate members. The park will only cater for CMCA members who own a self-contained vehicle.

The park will be managed by members, who are appointed as custodians for a short period of time. These fully trained custodians volunteer their time to look after and administer the park on behalf of the Club.

The park is conveniently located approximately 25 kilometres south of Devonport and will make for an ideal first stop when disembarking the Spirit of Tasmania ferry.

CMCA's Tasmania State Coordinator, Don Mackrill, alongside the Club's National Member Services Team, have worked closely with Kentish Council to execute this exciting project.
